TEMPORARY GIFTS	PERMANENT GIFTS
Temporary servant gifts Apostle, Prophet	Permanent servant gifts Evangelist, Shepherd, Teacher
Temporary service gifts Prophecy, Word of knowledge, Word of wisdom, Faith, Discerning of spirits	Permanent service gifts Government, Ministry, Rule
Temporary sign gifts Tongues, Interpretation of tongues, Healing, Working of miracles	Permanent serving gifts Exhortation, Helps, Giving, Mercy

Differentiating between water and Spirit baptism

	WATER BAPTISM	SPIRIT BAPTISM
Candidate	A saved sinner	Sinner upon believing
Element	Water	The Holy Spirit
Baptiser	Another Christian	The Lord Jesus Christ
Result	Good conscience	Union with the body of Christ

Differentiating between 'baptism in' and 'filling with' the Spirit

BAPTISM IN THE SPIRIT Key reference: 1 Cor 12:13	FILLING WITH THE SPIRIT Key reference: Eph 5:18
A fact to be believed	A command to be obeyed
Is true positionally of all believers	Should be true conditionally of all believers
Relates to a believer's <i>standing</i> in Christ	Relates to a believer's <i>state</i> <i>or daily walk</i> with the Lord
Spoken of in the <i>past tense</i> of all believers	Present passive imperative used; "keep on being filled"
An unrepeatable once-for-all event at conversion	Must be constantly maintained throughout life
Brings a believer into Christ's body the church	Empowers the believer for worship and service
